PRESS RELEASE: “Christians From All Walks of Faith Unite for 10 Days of Prayer in St. Louis”

ST. LOUIS, Mo., September 10, 2020—This fall, 10 Days of Prayer: St. Louis is inviting Christians from across the region to join in prayer from September 19-28. As our city, our nation and our world experience pandemic fears, economic crisis, racial unrest, increasing crime and political turmoil, 10 Days of Prayer is an opportunity for unity rather than division between various groups and denominations.

Prayer events are scheduled at multi-denominational locations across the metropolitan area for this 10-day period, with many events also available to view online. Guided by a daily prayer plan, participants are encouraged to enter a time of personal reflection with a goal that their lives will begin to reflect the changes they want to see in the world. From that changed perspective, groups and individuals are then better equipped to engage with the many societal issues facing our communities.

10 Days of Prayer happened in St. Louis for the first time in 2019, serving as an introduction for many churches and organizations to partner in prayer and service throughout the region. Several of the organizations involved, including North County Pastors’ Group, Civil Righteousness and Pray for the Lou, originally formed in direct response to the unrest surrounding Ferguson and rising crime throughout the area. 10 Days of Prayer now brings these and other previously independent organizations together for the common purpose of praying and acting for change in and around St. Louis.

This year, 10 Days of Prayer: St. Louis will also coincide with the international 10 Days of Prayer movement, with an anticipated 120,000 people praying in more than 120 cities across America, and thousands more around the world.
