### Day 3: Monday, September 21

7 p.m. to 9 p.m., Gateway House of Prayer

Inspired by Isaiah 56:7 the Gateway House of Prayer ([gatewayhop.org](http://gatewayhop.org)) seeks to establish a House of Prayer that functions as a perpetual solemn assembly by gathering believers from across denominations and generations in St. Louis to corporately engage in ongoing, unified worship, prayer and fasting in the spirit of the tabernacle of David. The staff and volunteers invite you to join them as part of their ongoing ministry to host perpetual prayer for our region at the Gateway House of Prayer, 4646 S. You can be part of this movement in St. Louis! Attend 'the Return' Main Day Program Simulcast in St. Louis in person at Gateway House of Prayer, 4646 S. Lindbergh Blvd, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Attend the live event in Washington, D.C. or take part by simulcast wherever you are—in your home, church, town or city. You can follow the simulcast on The Return website ([www.thereturn.org](http://www.thereturn.org)) or on most Christian television networks. We will not be providing an in person simulcast for the Return Night Celebration scheduled from 5 - 8 pm, but encourage you to watch it on your own devices.

Those wishing to attend the D.C. event are asked to arrange their own transportation and lodging.

### **Day 9: Sunday, September 27 7 p.m. to 8 p.m., Clayton Community Church**

Clayton Community Church ([claytoncommunitychurch.com](http://claytoncommunitychurch.com)) was born from an effort to bring the good news of Jesus to the Jewish people of St. Louis. **Day 10: Monday, September 28**

**10:55 a.m. to 11:55 a.m., Prayer Walk with Plant Midwest (6 Locations)**

When it comes to Christ's mission and the command to make disciples, it all begins and ends with the local church. Plant Midwest and SEND St. Louis are about planting churches and planting churches begins with leadership. We hope you'll join us for an hour on Monday, September 28 at one of these six locations to obey the first instruction of Jesus when it comes to church planting. When you see that the need is great, the harvest is plentiful in a town or neighborhood, yet the workers are few, what does Jesus tell us to do? Ask the Father. Ask the Father to raise up planters, leaders, harvesters for the harvest field. Just choose a location, show up at that address a few minutes early and then at 10:55 a.m. you'll be part of a team of two or three to hit the streets together and ask God. **6 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., North City, 2543 N. Grand Blvd., St. Louis, MO 63106**

Over 5 years ago, after the shooting of Michael Brown, Pastor Jonathan Tremaine Thomas (J.T.) moved to Ferguson to start what has become a national and global movement committed to [Civil Righteousness](#). With its mission of racial reconciliation and restorative justice through spiritual, cultural and economic renewal, Civil Righteousness hopes to restore all persons, places and things; while pursuing wholeness and moral excellence according to the biblical pattern.

Kurt Wilson, after having served around the world, moved to the Dutchtown neighborhood with a call for prayer. He is perhaps best known for the recent [Pray for the Lou](#) event, in which all 79 neighborhoods in the city were covered in prayer, and which ended with a closing rally on the Delmar Divide, believing that "what was divided shall be united." Kurt can be found constantly praying all over the city.

Join us on the final night of 10 Days of Prayer at what many in our city call "ground zero." We will be outside on a vacant lot standing in a "Kairos Moment" as the church of St. Louis. This isn't for the faint of heart, as this area is known for drugs and prostitution, but we believe the light shines brightest in the darkness. It is time to arise and shine and worship and pray together at one of the lowest places in our city, and lift up Jesus. Street parking available.
